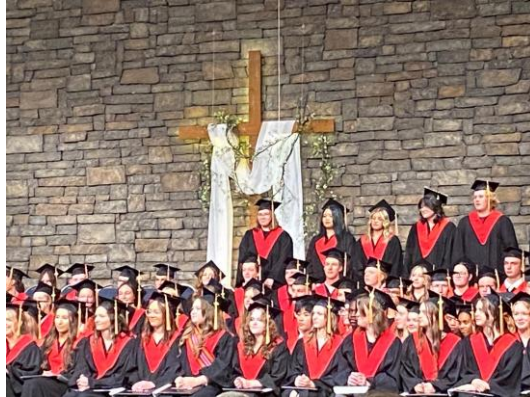

---

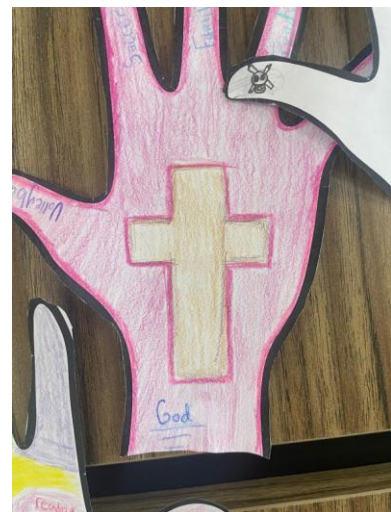
