I, Anara Dzhorabaeva, am a teacher and a parishioner of the Evangelical Christian Church Word of God in Osh, Kyrgyzstan.

My ministry is to children with disabilities in the village of Nurdar, where there are 262 children, 45 of whom are bedridden. We constantly hold events with children in 5 schools, we want healthy children to get closer to children with disabilities. We are constantly looking for sponsors for events and social assistance. We cooperate with various foundations; we turn to personal acquaintances and friends. December 2 the whole world celebrates Disability Day and Christmas. We ask you to look into the hearts and provide financial assistance to these children.

My name is Anara Asanovna Zhorobaeva. I am a teacher and a church minister.

Since 2008, I have been serving children with disabilities in the village of Nurdar, where there are 262 children.

Over the years, the foundation has provided:

- 25 children with wheelchairs;
- 30 children with scooters;
- 45 children with walkers;
- 5 young people with scholarships;
- Annual support from 15 volunteers.

Each year, with the help of the foundation and sponsors:

- 10-15 orphaned children enjoy a summer holiday at Issyk-Kul;
- 25-30 orphaned children receive winter and summer clothing and shoes;
- We organize summer camps for children with special needs.



Goals of the Foundation:

1. Providing assistance to children with disabilities.
2. Supporting parents of children with disabilities to improve their family's financial situation.
3. Offering help to orphans and homeless people.
4. Established a school for parents in Osh and Nurdar village



The foundation conducts significant work in organizing activities for children with disabilities:

- Three-day children's programs;
- Festive events dedicated to special occasions;
- Meetings with partners and volunteers to address children's issues;
- New Year's celebrations with gift distribution;
- Trainings and seminars for parents of children with disabilities;
- Collaboration with the Evangelical Christian Church in Osh;
