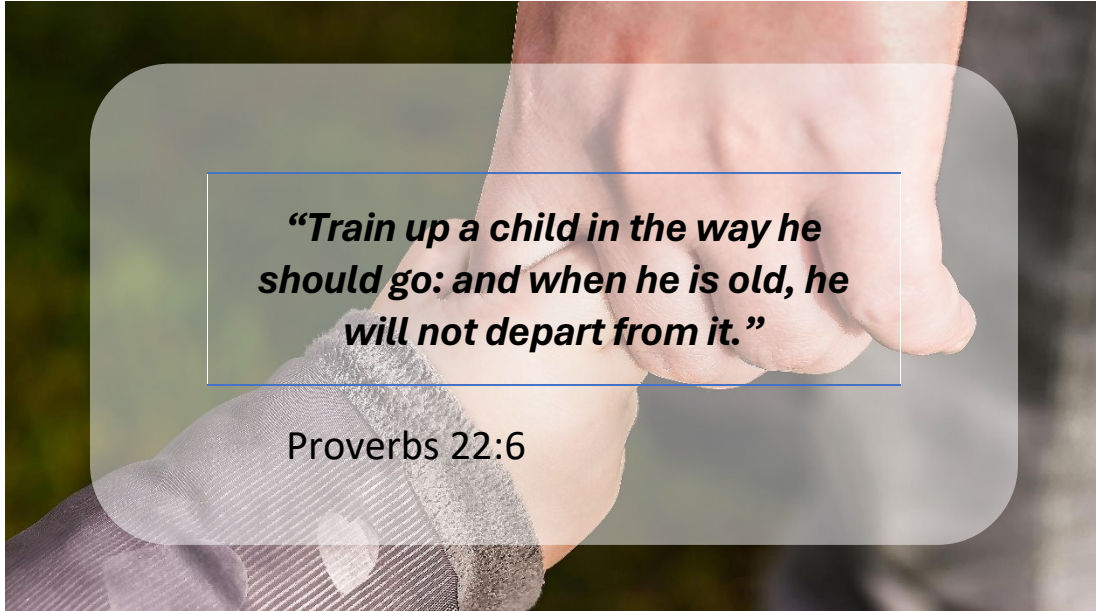


Sixteen13 Ministry

We are planning 2 mission trips in 2026.

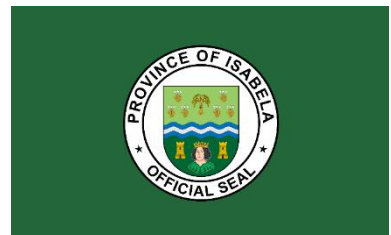
Camp Brazil in Brazil

A team went to Brazil in 2022 and met with Marcos and Claudia; leaders in a mission called Camp Brazil. They focus on discipling youth. After a few years those who were discipled assist to learn and lead in the future. Children in the program are able to gain 'credits' as they complete tasks, such as memorizing scripture. The leaders host camp events where kids can sing praise and worship with leaders, play games and purchase items such as clothes, food, toys, notebooks, and so on using these credits. We go to conferences, churches, small groups and other events to share the gospel, our testimonies and encouragement. In 2026 kids will go to camp. We will take a team of youth to this camp to connect with the youth in Brazil. This will be discipleship training. We will also be going to churches and speaking on how to reach youth.



Isabela, Philippines

We plan on having a team go to the Philippines in November of 2026. Our goal is to connect with the locals of Isabela and spend time sharing the gospel and distributing Christmas gifts. The focus will be humanitarian relief, so the gifts will include food purchased from local farmers to feed the community. We will be sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ in the local school and village of Isabela. In 2023, this school received action Bibles from our ministry with the goal of having Bible studies with the students added to their curriculum. The name of the school is Ramos Elementary School.



Ukrainian VBS

Andrii and a team led a Ukrainian VBS on the Sixteen13 Ministry property. The youth had a blast with activities, meals, and games that the team prepared for the weekend. Many of the activities included interactive ways to learn about Jesus Christ.

Spanish Ministry by Diana Harder – Mujer Virtuosa

My name is Dina Harder, and I am married to the love of my life Darryl Harder. We have two wonderful children: Tyler and Julianna. I am Mexican, and as an immigrant to this country, I know the challenges and loneliness that life outside our country of origin, being away from family and friends can bring. Two years ago, I met a lovely Hispanic lady through a local organization and helped her as a translator. We became friends, she was dealing with an illness which, sadly, ended her life. I was able to share the love of Jesus and the good news of the gospel with her, and she joyfully accepted the invitation and got baptized shortly after. And while she is enjoying Heaven with her Saviour, her sons were left to grieve the only parent they had. I am happy to say, her oldest son is now part of our family. and the youngest lives happily in another home.

These events have led me to understand some of the trials that refugees and immigrants face when arriving in a new country. I have been actively helping privately, but now is time to do it with the help of

a ministry that can concentrate on lending a hand to the Spanish speaking community. I love the Lord and am passionate about teaching God's Word to women, and with the help of Sixteen13 Ministry this can be accomplished.

Mujer Virtuosa is a place where Spanish speaking ladies can gather around the table to study God's Word and discuss relevant topics. It is an opportunity to share the gospel, share and enjoy a delicious meal, make new friends, and have an opportunity to shop affordable clothing as well!

Starting a Christian School in Mexico – Led by Hector

Hector and Ruth Nunez are graduates of Puerto Rico Baptist College. Hector got saved when he was sixteen years old. He got the chance to go to Christian camp where he surrendered his life to the Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord opened door for him to go to Puerto Rico Baptist College, in Bayamon Puerto Rico. Where he got a degree on bible. By the Grace of God, he continues to teach at the Bible Institute to young man and women call by God to Christian ministry.

The Lord led them to Iglesia Bautista Palabra Viva in 2008. They were sent as missionaries of their home church. Ever since, they have been serving the Lord at Palabra Viva. They have had the privilege of preaching the Gospel door-to-door, holding evangelistic campaigns at church, reaching the kids of the surroundings through bible clubs, teaching bible studies at homes of the brethren, helping in Christian education, teaching the youth of the church and helping to preach in other sister churches. The have continually preached the gospel, helping the brethren of the church grow in their faith.

The Lord has led Iglesia Bautista Palabra Viva to pray and depend on God to purchase a piece of property. This property will give more space to continue to grow in the ministry. Palabra Viva has the vision to begin a Christian ministry of education. This property represents the space of the classrooms we need for the Christian school.

We called this project: Joshua Project. Just as Joshua, the great conqueror, was used by God to get the Land the people of Israel needed, we as well are doing great efforts to get the piece of property we need for our ministry.

The property is 200 mts². The total cost of the Property is \$25,000 American dollars. We already have \$5,000. We are praying for 160 brave "Joshuas" that would join us in prayer that the Lord may be propitious in our need. And to join with us in our effort to get our promise land.
