Meet Flory, a local ministry leader

Our community is extremely diverse. We are committed to sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with everyone. To better connect with different cultures and get through any language barriers, we have a diverse leadership team and are able to connect with 14 different languages. Here are some of our leaders.

Flory (Board Member of Sixteen13 Ministry).

Speaks Swahili, French and English.

Flory leads our African outreach through evangelism. He uses donated resources such as food to help those struggling in our community and build relationships. Flory reaches 8 families, and is hoping to build even more connections.

'My name is Flory Babati, and I started this ministry to reach everyone because there are still many people who don't believe that Jesus Christ is the Saviour. Some who do believe don't have time for prayer due to life circumstances. The purpose of this ministry is to evangelize, sharing the gospel of Christ and bring hope to everyone who is lost in the darkness of this world. I saw many people getting lost, especially young people getting involved in drugs and alcohol. I said, "What can I do to bring them to Christ. How can I bring them back to the Christian life?" At that time, I decided to do something and to show them the love of Christ, who was crucified and died for us.

'For now, we have reached 8 families, and we believe we will reach more in the year to come. With God, everything is possible. Sixteen13 Ministry is with us, and they give us support for everything we need to evangelize. I am thankful for all of the support with prayer, materials, finances and food to reach people. We started with only one, but today we have 8 families and 3 leaders in our group to reach African families. All of this shows the miracle God is doing in us. By ourselves, we cannot do it.

'I have a testimony to share: One day, I went to evangelize, and I met someone who welcomed me into his house. We started preaching to that person, and he said we can't stay long because he is hungry and he can't hear what we were saying or preaching. He told us he had 3 days left of food. I told him, "Don't worry, our God is a God of miracles. Just believe and pray to him. You will see the miracle, and he will change your life." After that, I brought him food from Sixteen13 Ministry. He was so happy! The food helped us to continue to evangelize, and after 4 days, I received good news. The man opened his heart to God, and he accepted Jesus as his Saviour and was baptized. Our goal in the future is to work with a church and to bring all those lost souls to this church.'



CHRISTMAS

Our gratitude goes out to our team of staff and volunteers who put together 677 stockings for our ministry. Hannah and a team are packaging 200 Christmas gifts in the Philippines (They don't normally use stockings). The stockings are filled with Christian colouring books, crayons, chocolate, candy, tracks, booklets, and Bibles to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. We are also grateful to the Winkler Berghthaler Mennonite Church, which has been donating the colouring books for five years.



Cherry and Elmhar, with a huge team, hosted a Christmas Party on December 20. We celebrated with food, games, dancing, and fellowship. We always share a devotional and prayer. Everyone gets the chance to hear about Jesus Christ, learn the truth of the gospel, and accept Christ into their lives!

Mission Trips

In our last report, we announced that we were planning 2 mission trips. Due to the expensive ticket price, we unfortunately will not be able to fly to Brazil with our group. Instead, we will be planning a mission trip in 2027. The destination is not yet confirmed.

We have fully raised the necessary funds for our mission trip to Isabela, Philippines, in November 2026. The team is looking forward to connecting with the local community, building relationships, evangelizing, and preparing, as God leads, to establish a community of God-fearing individuals who will disciple others in the community to study the Word of God and grow in their relationship with Christ.



Sharing the Gospel

We continue to share the Gospel regularly in local schools. Tiffany is currently working on in-depth studies, while Harold is focused on topicals and teaching Hebrew and Greek words in the Bible. Our challenge is that we speak to mixed ages, from 5-13 and making the message engaging and educational for all of them.

SUPPLICATION AND THANKSGIVING

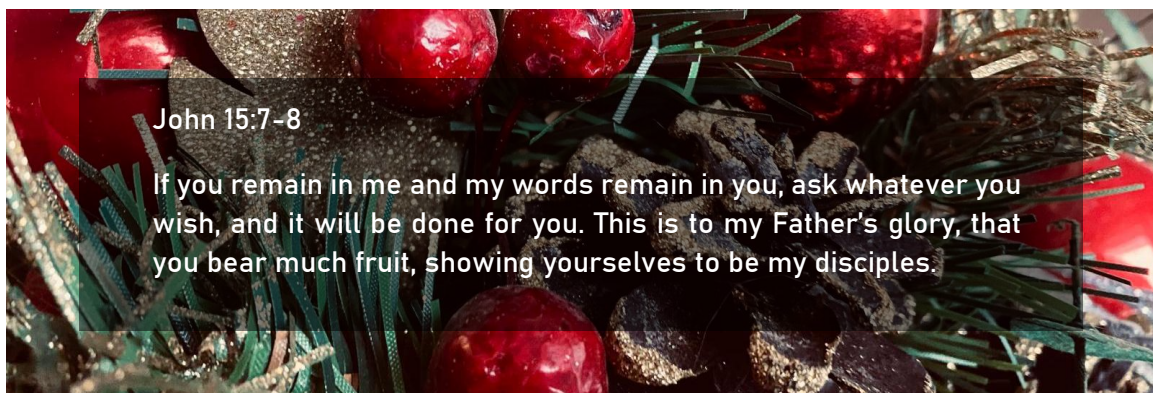

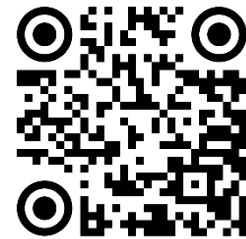
